

## May 4 – 8: Julian Family Fiddle Camp

From May 4 to 8, Julian Family Fiddle Camp will host a lineup of talented North American musicians who, along with students from many states and countries, will come together to immerse themselves in the joy of learning and playing acoustic string music.

Some of the most well-known performers and teachers who'll participate, include internationally-respected Appalachian-style, old-time fiddler Bruce Molsky; world-renowned mandolin master John Reischman; Caleb Klauder, one of the founders of the popular Foghorn String Band; and Klauder's wife, roots music star Reeb Willms.

In total, 15 instructors — a veritable who's-who in the acoustic music scene today — will teach and perform classes in fiddle, mandolin, cello, guitar, banjo and upright bass, with short special-topic workshops including vocals and harmonica.


#### July 30: Sip of Julian







Ticket holders have the option of visiting participating locations at their own pace, or taking advantage of the relaxing and comfortable shuttle vans for an additional fee.


Attendees must be age 21 or older. ID verification

There's nothing quite like backcountry camping for kicking back in the wilderness under a blanket of stars and leaving civilization behind. And Julian offers the experience you're looking for, whether it's a short weekend of solitude or a longer stay in the foothills.





#### **CUYAMACA RANCHO STATE PARK**

If your goal is a traditional camping experience in a beautiful location, look no further than this gem in the California State Parks system. Cuyamaca Rancho boasts more than 24,000 acres of oak and conifer forests with a mixture of meadows and hidden waterfalls, all with more than 100 miles of hiking trails.

There are two campgrounds within the park – Paso Picacho has 85 campsites, and Green Valley has 81, each with a picnic table and fire ring. Reservations may be made by calling 800-444-PARK. For information, visit parks.ca.gov.

If you'd prefer to travel by horseback or you're ready to carry in your gear under the strength of your own two legs, check out the Granite Springs and Arroyo Seco sites, which are both available on a first-come. first-served basis.

The park also offers interpretive programs in the summer months, which can be an enjoyable way to learn more about the wildlife and landscape of the area. With countless picnic sites; miles of hiking, biking and equestrian trails; views of Anza-Borrego Desert State Park; and wildlife galore, there's no

shortage of opportunities to get your wilderness fix. Load up your camping gear of choice and get ready to watch the beauty of the night sky unfold in the stunning mountain wilderness.





## **A Small Town** With a Long History

Civil War veterans from Georgia headed west to seek their fortunes in a new, mostly unsettled land. Among these were cousins Drue Bailey and Mike Julian and their siblings, who found a lush meadow to their liking between the Volcan Mountains and the Cuyamacas.

The settlement was eventually named "Julian," in honor of Mike Julian, who was later elected as the San Diego County Assessor.

The town was never large. At most, it boasted a population of about 600 - more than reside in the historic district today. Rumor has it that Julian almost became San Diego's county seat a few years after gold was discovered.


Cattleman Fred Coleman found the first fleck of gold in a creek in early 1870, launching San Diego's first and only gold rush. It was short-lived, lasting from 1870 until around 1900, with some mining continuing on a smaller scale. One local resident's grandfather is listed on his World War I enlistment papers as a hoist operator at the Golden Chariot mine.


Many of the early pioneers are buried in the Julian Haven of Rest Pioneer Cemetery. It is located on Farmer Road, on a hill just north of town, and is open to the public.


As the gold rush ended, pioneers stayed and began cultivating the rich land.


While many crops were planted and animals pastured, Julian proved to be a fine place to grow apples. In fact, Julian apples - "Twentyone varieties of well-grown and carefully selected apples" - received the Bronze Wilder Medal, a top honor from the American Pomological Society, awarded at the 1907 Tri-centennial Exposition held in Jamestown, Va.

Apples continue to be cultivated in Julian. Their sweet, fresh flavor draws thousands to the mountains each fall, when visitors find fruit stands overflowing with crisp fruit, homemade cider and other delicacies, and can enjoy U-pick activities.





members and tourists alike.



**Canyon Oak Trail:** 1.25 miles that connects to the Desert View Trail.

**Kelly Ditch Trail:** 5.75 miles, great for walking or riding horses. Trail connects the park with Cuyamaca Rancho State Park and Lake Cuyamaca.

**Indian Trail**: Easy .75 mile one way. Well-marked trail to seasonal waterfall. Best in spring and early summer.

**Green Valley Falls Trail:** Approximately 4.5-mile loop.

**Azalea Glen Loop Trail:** Moderate 3.6 miles. Yearround stream. Native Kumeyaay grinding holes may be seen about .5 mile from trailhead.

**Juaquapin Trail**: Moderate 3 miles, scenic loop climbing via East Site Trail with a steep return by Dyar Spring Trail.

Conejo Spring Trail: Moderately strenuous 3.5 miles to summit. Rugged ascent over north shoulder of Cuyamaca Peak. Connects to paved road leading to summit. Descent to campground by paved fire road.

**Stonewall Peak Trail:** Moderately strenuous round trip of 4 miles, 900 feet gain in elevation, 360-degree view at top.

**Oakzanita Peak Trail:** Moderately strenuous 8-mile loop with 1,300 feet gain in elevation, and 5-mile loop with 1,200 feet gain in elevation.
