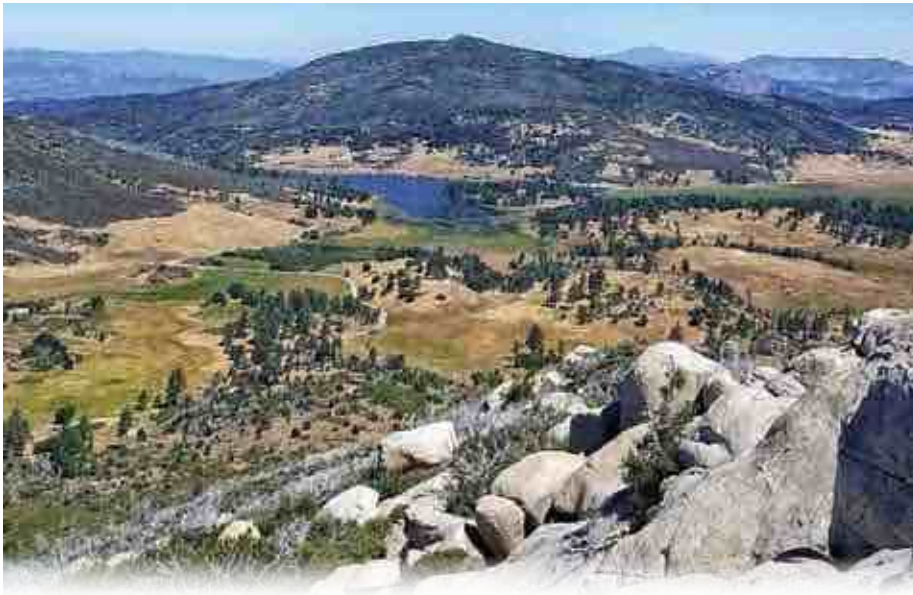

May 4 – 8: Julian Family Fiddle Camp

From May 4 to 8, Julian Family Fiddle Camp will host a lineup of talented North American musicians who, along with students from many states and countries, will come together to immerse themselves in the joy of learning and playing acoustic string music.

Some of the most well-known performers and teachers who'll participate, include internationally-respected Appalachian-style, old-time fiddler Bruce Molsky; world-renowned mandolin master John Reischman; Caleb Klauder, one of the founders of the popular Foghorn String Band; and Klauder's wife, roots music star Reeb Willms.

In total, 15 instructors – a veritable who's-who in the acoustic music scene today – will teach and perform classes in fiddle, mandolin, cello, guitar, banjo and upright bass, with short special-topic workshops including vocals and harmonica.

This year's camp will be at Camp Whispering Winds off Harrison Park Road in Julian. Public concerts will take place the evenings of May 6 and 7. For information about attending the camp or public concerts, visit familyfiddlecamp.com.

A Small Town With a Long *History*

Civil War veterans from Georgia headed west to seek their fortunes in a new, mostly unsettled land. Among these were cousins Drue Bailey and Mike Julian and their siblings, who found a lush meadow to their liking between the Volcan Mountains and the Cuyamacas.

The settlement was eventually named "Julian," in honor of Mike Julian, who was later elected as the San Diego County Assessor.

The town was never large. At most, it boasted a population of about 600 – more than reside in the historic district today. Rumor has it that Julian almost became San Diego's county seat a few years after gold was discovered.

Cattleman Fred Coleman found the first fleck of gold in a creek in early 1870, launching San Diego's first and only gold rush. It was short-lived, lasting from 1870 until around 1900, with some mining continuing on a smaller scale. One local resident's grandfather is listed on his World War I enlistment papers as a hoist operator at the Golden Chariot mine.

Many of the early pioneers are buried in the Julian Haven of Rest Pioneer Cemetery. It is located on Farmer Road, on a hill just north of town, and is open to the public.

As the gold rush ended, pioneers stayed and began cultivating the rich land.

While many crops were planted and animals pastured, Julian proved to be a fine place to grow apples. In fact, Julian apples – "Twenty-one varieties of well-grown and carefully selected apples" – received the Bronze Wilder Medal, a top honor from the American Pomological Society, awarded at the 1907 Tri-centennial Exposition held in Jamestown, Va.

Apples continue to be cultivated in Julian. Their sweet, fresh flavor draws thousands to the mountains each fall, when visitors find fruit stands overflowing with crisp fruit, homemade cider and other delicacies, and can enjoy U-pick activities.

Kelly Ditch Trail: 5.75 miles, great for walking or riding horses. Trail connects the park with Cuyamaca Rancho State Park and Lake Cuyamaca.

Trail maps and information are available at Paso Picacho and Green Valley Falls camp kiosks, 8-4 daily.

Cuyamaca Peak: 3.5-mile hike from Paso Picacho at 5,000 feet to elevation of 6,512 feet. Views of deserts to the east, coast to the west and Lake Cuyamaca at the bottom.

Paseo Nature Trail: Easy .5-mile loop, scenic and level.

Indian Trail: Easy .75 mile one way. Well-marked trail to seasonal waterfall. Best in spring and early summer.

Green Valley Falls Trail: Approximately 4.5-mile loop.

Azalea Glen Loop Trail: Moderate 3.6 miles. Year-round stream. Native Kumeyaay grinding holes may be seen about .5 mile from trailhead.

Juaquapin Trail: Moderate 3 miles, scenic loop climbing via East Site Trail with a steep return by Dyar Spring Trail.

Conejo Spring Trail: Moderately strenuous 3.5 miles to summit. Rugged ascent over north shoulder of Cuyamaca Peak. Connects to paved road leading to summit. Descent to campground by paved fire road.

Stonewall Peak Trail: Moderately strenuous round trip of 4 miles, 900 feet gain in elevation, 360-degree view at top.

Oakzanita Peak Trail: Moderately strenuous 8-mile loop with 1,300 feet gain in elevation, and 5-mile loop with 1,200 feet gain in elevation.

East: Hwy. 79 Trailhead: Take Hwy. 78 into Santa Ysabel. Turn north onto Hwy. 79. Trailhead is 1.5 miles north of Santa Ysabel, south of the Santa Ysabel Mission.

West: Take Hwy. 78 to Santa Ysabel. Staging area is one mile west of Santa Ysabel on Hwy. 78 at Call Box 495.

VOLCAN MOUNTAIN PRESERVE

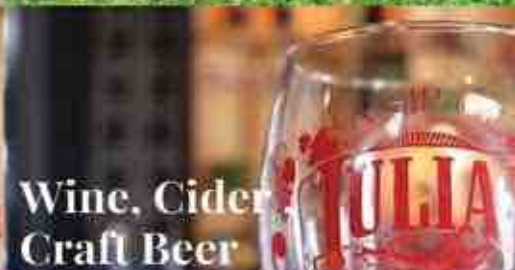
