The secret is out about hiking in the Julian area. Many of the hikes have been featured in blogs and publications.

There are so many options for hiking in our area that you'll want to come back time and time again to experience all the beauty that our area has to offer.

Cuyamaca Rancho State Park

(760) 765-0755 Located South of Julian on Highway 79

Hiking trails and day use are open at the Green Valley (15.8 miles from Julian) and Paso Picacho (11 miles from Julian) Campground. Trail maps and information are available at Kiosk, 8:00AM to 4:00PM daily. Parking Fee

Azalea Glen Loop Trail

MODERATE 4-mile loop, with a 550 ft. gain in elevation. Partially shaded in summer, sheltered in winter. Walk along one of the few seasonal streams in this park. Trailhead and parking are at PASO PICACHO campground parking lot.

Conejo Spring Trail

MODERATLY STRENUOUS 3.5 sometimes steep miles to summit. Gain in elevation 1650 ft. Rugged ascent over the north shoulder of Cuyamaca Peak. Trail becomes a streambed after heavy rain or snowmelt. Connects to paved road leading to summit. Descent to campground by paved fire road. Trail head and parking at PASO PICACHO campground.

Stonewall Peak Trail

MODERATE 2.0 miles each way, steady gain in elevation of 900 ft. Suitable for energetic youngster. Well-graded trail to the summit of Stonewall Peak, last section on exposed ridge but with steps and handrail. Great views from the peak. Trail head and parking is across from entrance to PASO PICACHO Campground at the picnic area.

Juaquapin Trail

MODERATE 3-mile scenic loop climbing via East Side Trail and Juaquapin Trail with a steepish return by Dyar Spring Trail. Gain in elevation 400 ft. Well-graded trail through oaks, open meadows, partly by a flowing stream. Opportunities for wildflowers and deer. Trail head and parking at turnoff for the Park Museum.

Green Valley Falls Trail

EASY 1.5 miles round trip, suitable for children. Well-marked trail to pretty (but seasonal) waterfall. Best in spring and early summer. Trail head and parking located at picnic area parking lot at GREEN VALLEY campground.


HISTORY

The Julian Historical Society

The Julian Historical Society was incorporated in 1963, when a few local historians got together to preserve Julian's past for our future generations.

The Stageline Garage was built in Pioneer Park and is now home to the 1912 Mack Stage that carried passengers to Julian in the 1900's, and a 1924 Cadillac bus. The Historical Society, with the help of volunteers from the Campo Transport Museum, restored both vehicles over many years of dedicated volunteer labor.

The Witch Creek School building, the Stageline Garage and the restored vehicles, and many other artifacts may be seen by visiting Pioneer Park, 2133 Fourth Street, Julian, CA. 92036.

Museums are open to the public the first full weekend of the month and every weekend in October from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm.

JULIAN TOWN SQUARE PROJECT




The Julian Community Heritage Foundation

Founded in 2017, under a shared community vision for a town square park on the corner of Main St. and Washington St. The "corner lot," as it had come to be known, had been sitting vacant and neglected for decades. It was a serious blight in our historic district and with a controversial past, as it was.

Town Square site plans were submitted to the county, and we expect to obtain to begin phase one this spring/summer. Town Square phase 1 includes: Irrigation & electric infrastructure, planters with native species, donor wall, benches, tables, and maintenance building.


Julian is a small town. It is not incorporated, and there is no "local government." Julian is under the jurisdiction of County of San Diego. As such, the amenities in town are provided by volunteers. Julian Chamber of Commerce provides 25 trashcans around town and has hired folks to empty them daily. Public restrooms are also provided by the Chamber, which is thankful to San Diego County Supervisor Joel Anderson, who allocated grant monies to help provide these amenities to visitors. In order to help keep this community a place people love to visit again and again:

- Please don't litter. Visitors are here to experience the fresh mountain air and beautiful scenery. So is everyone else, including those who live and work here. Please put litter in its place.
- Please treat the public restrooms with care. Maintaining public restrooms is the Chamber's most costly service. Vandalism and theft are a constant struggle. Please help keep these restrooms in service by respecting them.
- Please park only in designated areas. The roads are narrow in the backcountry. Those who park where they don't belong may hinder emergency services.
- Bring refillable water bottles. There is not a sophisticated recycling program here, so everyone's help is appreciated.
- Respect private property. Guests are asked to be responsible and respect local homes, farms and orchards.

- Share the road. Most ways into Julian are by two-lane roads, and it may be tempting to pass on a double-yellow line. Please be respectful of other drivers and pass only when permitted by law and use turnouts if there are several vehicles behind you. As an added caution, please watch for motorcycles.
- Check road conditions. Snow and ice are common during the winter months.
- Be prepared with chains, if required. For road updates, visit Caltrans Quickmap at quickmap.dot.ca.gov.
- Respect the wildlife. Visitors are likely to see deer, turkeys, foxes and racoons, to name a few. Mountain lions and coyotes also call the Julian area home. Please don't approach, feed or harass any wildlife you are lucky enough to happen upon them.
- Please don't pick the flowers. Imagine the disappointment of traveling to Julian to see the wildflowers, daffodils and lilacs, only to find there are none. Did you know that every year, hundreds of daffodil bulbs are planted locally by volunteers. Please be respectful of those efforts and refrain from going onto private property to "just pick one." It's unfair and robs others of the opportunity to enjoy them.

It's easy to exhibit courtesy and care when visiting the Julian area. The community is very grateful when folks choose to visit. Join with residents in helping to keep the town safe and enjoyable for all who live here and visit.


